ON INSURANCE AND RISK MANAGEMENT (CICIRM 2026)**

Kunming, China

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

CICIRM 2026 will cover a broad range of topics in insurance, risk management, and actuarial science. Submissions focusing on the Chinese market and government programs are especially encouraged. Parallel sessions will be conducted in both English and Chinese.

Topics of interest include, but are not limited to:

- Development and regulation of insurance markets
- Insurance economics
- Theory and practice of risk management
- Property and liability insurance
- Life and health insurance
- Pension and social security
- Actuarial science
- Behavioral insurance
- InsurTech and related technology issues
- Green insurance and economic sustainability

We warmly welcome original research paper submissions to the conference. Please review and follow the requirements outlined below:

- ✓ **Originality:** Submitted conference paper should be original works that have not been published or made publicly available on any platform, including online publications.
- ✓ **Language:** conference papers may be written in either Chinese or English.
- ✓ **Author Anonymity Instructions:** As the conference uses a double-blind review procedure, authors are asked to keep their manuscripts free of any identifying information, including names, affiliations, and contact details, to ensure an unbiased review.
- ✓ **Submission Format:** To meet the submission system requirements, all papers must be submitted in PDF format.



- ✓ **Submission Process:** Please visit the Conference Submission System at <https://www.cfrn.com.cn/cfrn/meet/paper/6> to submit your paper via the China Financial Research Network. Registered users will be automatically redirected to the submission page after logging in. New users must first complete registration; once registered and logged in, they will be directed to the paper submission page. Please refer to the attached document titled “Demonstration of the CICIRM 2026 Submission Process on the China Financial Research Network (English Version)” for detailed submission instructions.
- ✓ **Presenters & Participants:** Authors of accepted papers will be invited to deliver an in-person presentation at the conference. Authors whose papers are not selected for on-site presentations may apply for an online presentation by submitting a request to ccirm@sem.tsinghua.edu.cn, or they may choose to attend the conference in person without giving a presentation.
- **Submission Deadline:** January 31, 2026;

Organized Sessions

The CICIRM 2026 will feature several organized sessions. Prospective organizers should follow the process and requirements outlined below:

✓ Application Process

Define the theme of the organized session, focusing on insurance, risk management, and actuarial science, ensuring both relevance and timeliness.

Contact potential speakers (each organized session is recommended to include four presentations).

Submit a complete proposal to the conference organizing committee.

✓ Required Information for Proposal

Theme of the organized session.

Titles and abstracts of all presentations.

Names, affiliations, and contact information (phone and email) of speakers, discussants (if any), and session chair.

✓ Submission Requirements

Organized session proposals must be submitted to the designated email ccirm@sem.tsinghua.edu.cn by January 18, 2026, after confirming all speakers.

All presenters in the parallel sessions are required to submit their conference papers through the conference submission system at <https://www.cfrn.com.cn/cfrn/meet/paper/6>. Please refer to the attached document titled “Demonstration of the CICIRM 2026 Submission Process on the China Financial Research Network (English Version)” for detailed submission instructions.

Doctoral Forum

The Doctoral Forum at CICIRM is a dedicated academic platform designed for PhD students. It provides an opportunity to engage in in-depth discussions of individual research topics with experienced experts and to gain access to cutting-edge academic insights



and professional guidance. PhD students whose papers are successfully selected through the anonymous review process will receive an official invitation to take part in the Doctoral Forum.

Suggested Time Allocation for Parallel Session Presentations

- ✓ **Regular Sessions:** Each session includes 4 presentations, with a total of 30 minutes per presentation, consisting of 20 minutes for the author's oral presentation, 6 minutes for the discussant's comments, and 4 minutes for Q&A.
- ✓ **Organized Sessions:** Each session includes 4 presentations, with a total of 30 minutes per presentation, which includes 20 minutes for the author's oral presentation, 6 minutes for the discussant's comments, and 4 minutes for Q&A.
- ✓ **Doctoral Forum:** Each session includes 4 presentations, with a total of 30 minutes per presentation, consisting of 20 minutes for the author's presentation and 10 minutes for comments from an invited discussant.
- ✓ **Student Session:** Each session includes up to 8 presentations, with a total of 15 minutes per presentation, which includes 12 minutes for the author's presentation and 3 minutes for comments from the session chair.

All presenters are required to prepare PowerPoint slides (PPT) for their oral presentations. Discussants are also encouraged to use PPT during their comments.

Authors unable to attend in person may present online via Zoom or Tencent Meeting. However, Doctoral Forum presenters must attend and present in person.

Best Paper Awards

The conference will recognize outstanding contributions with the following awards:

1. Best Paper Awards of the China Conference on Insurance and Risk Management

Four awards will be presented:

- Best Chinese Paper in Insurance and Risk Management
- Best English Paper in Insurance and Risk Management
- Best Chinese Paper in Actuarial and Quantitative Analysis
- Best English Paper in Actuarial and Quantitative Analysis

Each award-winning paper will receive a prize of ¥2,500. Selections will be made by independent reviews conducted by members of the Academic Committee.

2. Honorary Awards for Excellent Papers of the China Conference on Insurance and Risk Management

Both the Insurance and Risk Management group and the Actuarial and Quantitative Analysis group will each select three papers for Honorary Awards. The review process will be carried out independently by members of the Academic Committee.

Conference Proceedings

Authors who intend to publish their papers in the conference proceedings may, after the conference concludes, format their manuscripts according to **CICIRM 2026 Proceedings Full Paper Template (English Version)** (available for download on the website <https://ccirm.sem.tsinghua.edu.cn/uploads/master/file/20251111/6912cd790ae82.doc>) and submit the finalized Word document (.doc or .docx) as an email attachment. The file should be named “Author Name + Paper Title” and sent to the conference email address (ccirm@sem.tsinghua.edu.cn).

Resubmitted papers may be written in either Chinese or English. For manuscripts submitted in Chinese, the following elements must also be provided in English within the document: paper title, abstract, keywords, and author contact details (name, mailing address, phone number, and email), as well as references.

If the original references are in Chinese, please translate them into English, remove the Chinese versions, retain only the English translations, and indicate “(in Chinese)” after each translated entry. Please refer to the full paper template for detailed formatting requirements.

The Proceedings of the 2026 International Conference on Insurance and Risk Management in China will be formally published by Tsinghua University Press with an ISBN. Each paper included will also be assigned a unique DOI by the China Academic Journals (CD Edition) Electronic Publishing House.

For papers to be considered for inclusion in the conference proceedings, at least one author must register for the conference and deliver the presentation, either onsite or online, in the corresponding session.
